Competition Rules

Art 1

The recipes must be of Italian origins. The entries must be home made.

Art. 2

There are three categories:

Antipasti freddi: cold pasta or rice salads, stuffed vegetables, etc..
Pizze o torte salate: pizzas, quiches, pie, focaccia bread, etc...

Dolci: desserts at your choice

Art. 3

Each participant has to bring the dish ready to be shown. To verify the paternity of the dish, the participant will be "interrogated" by the *Triunvirato De Iustitia Coquinaria*. Each participant must fill in the enrolment form which will include providing:

- a fantasy name for the prepared dish;
- ingredients and quantities;
- preparation description;
- dish description (history, anecdotes, curiosities, etc..)

Art. 4

The dishes will be judged by a commission composed of 5 members:

- President of Società Dante Alighieri
- a gourmand
- a chef
- a young person
- a student of Dante Alighieri

The *Triunvirato De Iustitia Coquinaria* is composed of President of Società Dante Alighieri, the gourmand and the chef.

Three awards will be assigned: best Antipasto freddo, best Torta salata, best Dolce. A special award, the "Sorriso di Dante" (Dante's smile), will be given to the most original and funny name among the competing dishes.

Art 5

Judges will be instructed to judge each entry on

•	Taste	45%
•	Execution	20%
•	Appearance	15%
•	Name of the recipe	10%
•	Originality of description	10%

The numbering will rank from 1 to 10 in each of the five evaluations.
